

COVID-19 Update May 7, 2020

Resuming Scheduled Outpatient Testing

May 7, 2020

As we took steps to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, we stopped performing many routine outpatient tests. Other testing continued throughout March and April, but volumes were intentionally limited as many non-emergency tests and routine tests were postposed.

Beginning Monday, we will resume these types of outpatient testing, in accordance with recommendations from the state Department of Health. While this resumption of scheduled testing will likely increase traffic in and out of the facility, we will maintain strict screening protocols and limit access to the hospital.

We will also continue to test patients at the Hospital and the Outpatient Diagnostic Center during the reduced hours at which we are currently operating.

At Uniontown Hospital: 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday - Friday, 6:30 a.m. to noon Saturday.

At the ODC: 6 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Monday – Friday.
