

VISITATION POLICY

- Visitors should arrive wearing a mask and **MUST** continue wearing one while in our facilities
- **DO NOT** visit if you are sick
- Staff may restrict visitation in areas with limited space
- See below for specific visitation guidance

Adult Inpatient Visitation

Two (2) visitors at a time, per day, from 10 a.m. - 8 p.m. Monday - Sunday

Visitors are asked to remain in the patient room during their visit

No admittance to the building after 7:45 p.m. daily

Emergency Department

One (1) visitor is permitted per patient at bedside

Visitors must enter and exit through Emergency Department entrance

All visitors will be required to stay in the patient's room and are asked to exit the building after visit

Outpatient Diagnostic Center

Adult patients are encouraged to come unaccompanied for diagnostic testing

Each patient is permitted to have one (1) person accompany them, as needed

*Masks must be worn at all times over the nose and mouth

Pediatric Inpatient Visitation

Pediatric patients will be permitted to have two (2) parent/guardian at bedside for the duration of their stay
(Parent/Guardian will follow all Inpatient Visitation guidelines as outlined above.)

Surgical Patient Visitation

One (1) visitor may accompany patients for outpatient surgical procedures

All visitors will be required to stay in designated waiting area

Visitors are permitted to leave and return following surgery

Primary & Specialty Care Offices

Adult patients are encouraged to come unaccompanied for diagnostic testing

Each patient is permitted to have one (1) person accompany them, as needed

*Masks must be worn at all times over the nose and mouth

COVID-19 Visitation

One (1) visitor is permitted at the time admission

Then, one (1) visitor is permitted every five (5) days, per system guidance

Diagnostic Testing at Hospital

Adult patients are encouraged to come unaccompanied for diagnostic testing

Each patient is permitted to have one (1) person accompany them, as needed

*Masks must be worn at all times over the nose and mouth
